Bridge flags: Why are the flags on the bridge down? Usually when the bridge flags are not being flown it is due to weather concerns such as high winds or electrical problems with the lights required to illuminate the flags at night. Legal Advice: I am going through a divorce and need some advice. Can the City Attorney help me? No. The city cannot give advice in any private legal matter. The City Attorney's office does not represent individuals in private legal matters. Regular elections: When are the city elections held? The primary election is held in September and the general election is held in November of evennumbered years. Polling places: Where do I go to vote? Your polling place is determined by where you live. Cost for extension of premises permit: What is the cost for an extension of premises permit? There is no fee for an extension of premises permit. Extension of premises or patio permit: How do I obtain a temporary or permanent extension of premises/patio permit? Contact the City Clerk's office. Liquor license application costs: How much does it cost to obtain a liquor license? Lake Havasu City charges a \$205.00 application fee a \$205.00 filing fee and the Police Department charges a \$29.00 fingerprint fee for a total of \$439.00. Regular liquor license applications: How do I obtain a liquor license? Contact the Arizona State Department of Liquor Licenses and Control by phone or through their website. Special event application: What is the deadline to submit my application for a special event? At least thirty days prior to the event. Incorporation of Lake Havasu City: When was the city incorporated? October 2 1978. Requests for information time frames: How long will it take to get the requested information? All requests are handled in a prompt manner as reasonably as possible. Cost for information: What is the cost for information? The first 10 pages are free and \$.50 per page for each additional page. High consumption: There is no way I could have used that much water. You either read incorrectly or there is something wrong with the meter. Sometimes it is very difficult to detect the reason for what seems to be an excessive amount of water used in any one month. We certainly do recognize that a meter might be misread and we can issue a service order to have the meter read verified. We have found however that most high water consumption can be directly related to an outside irrigation system. Some examples

are a stuck irrigation valve a broken bubbler head or a timer that is not set correctly. When the city's meters go bad they normally slow down and stop. This means that you would be under billed rather than over billed. Rate timeframes: Why isn't everyone paying for sewer? Everyone should pay for sewer now to help reduce the rates. The method of repayment for the wastewater system debt was presented to the voters as revenue secured debt; funds will be generated by user rates and fees not tax secured debt. Because of this customers do not pay for sewer until they are connected to the system. Sewer charges: Why is there a sewer charge on my water bill? I already paid my \$2000.00. The \$2000.00 is a one-time fee and is assessed to all new connections to the sewer system. The fee that is charged on the same bill as the water and trash is a consumption charge based on the amount of water going through the meter. Fees are calculated on either actual water consumption or a winter quarter average. Methods of payment on Lake Havasu City bills: How can I pay my bill from Lake Havasu City? Lake Havasu City accepts the following forms of payment: cash credit card checks cashier's checks money orders automatic bank drafting and online bank payments. These payment methods are acceptable for all bills received from Lake Havasu City. Lost and found area of the Police Department: recently left my wallet on top of my vehicle and it fell off somewhere as I was driving home. Does the Police Department have a lost and found area? Yes the Property and Evidence Division frequently receives property that has been found by citizens. Most common items include bicycles key rings backpacks wallets and purses. An appointment is required to pick up property. The Property and Evidence Division is open from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday except on legal holidays. Walk Away Program: My wife has dementia and occasionally walks away from the house without my knowing. What can I do to make sure she is identifiable if she is found wandering? The Lake Havasu City Police Department has a Walk Away Bracelet Program for senior citizens and the disabled who have a history or potential to walk away from their caregiver or nursing home. The caretaker or family member should call the Police Department for enrollment. This entails filling out a form with



The back has a client number and the non-emergency police dispatch telephone number. If the senior citizen is found wandering the neighborhood the police will be contacted and the senior citizen will be returned to their caregiver. Arrest warrant information: How can I clear my warrant? The Lake Havasu Consolidated Court issues warrants. There may be an outstanding warrant if you have missed an appearance date failed to comply with a court order or failed to pay a fine. Information regarding the amount of the warrant and other details may be obtained by calling the Lake Havasu Consolidated Court at (928) 453-0705. You can also visit the court which is located at 2001 College Drive Suite 148. Televisions in vehicles: I recently bought an in-dash DVD player so my family and I can watch movies in my truck while my family and I are taking trips to Lake Havasu City. Is this legal? No this is illegal. A person shall not drive a motor vehicle equipped with a television viewer or screen or any other means of visually receiving a television broadcast that is either:

- Located in the motor vehicle at any point forward of the back of the driver's seat.
- Visible directly or : indirectly to the driver while operating the motor vehicle.

Credit report checks: How can I find out if my identity has been stolen? The best way to find out is to monitor your accounts and bank statements each month and check your credit card reports on a regular basis. If you check your credit report regularly you may be able to limit the damage caused by identity theft. Personal watercraft: My family and I recently bought a couple of personal watercraft's. What safety equipment do we need to have while driving our personal watercraft's? A person shall not operate a personal watercraft unless each person aboard is wearing a wearable personal flotation device that is approved by the United States Coast Guard. 
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


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cleaned up the perception is that the behavior is condoned and the area is not being watched. This opens the door for other property crimes and creates an environment that tolerates violent crimes such as serious assaults and robbery. The vast majority of graffiti vandalism is the result of "tagging" committed by juveniles for the main reason of recognition. Taggers are not necessarily gang members they do not reflect any specific socio-economic background and they come from all neighborhoods of the city. Alcohol in city parks: I am having a family reunion at one of the local parks in Lake Havasu City. Are we allowed to drink alcohol in the park? The only way that you can drink alcohol in a Lake Havasu City park is to obtain a permit from the city. If you do not obtain a permit to drink alcohol in the city park you could be arrested. Off-road vehicles in the city limits: I live next to the power line easement in Lake Havasu City and there are a lot of off-road vehicles such as dirt bikes riding up and down this easement at all hours of the day. Is it legal for these types of vehicles to be in this area? No it is illegal for off-road vehicles to drive on the power line easement. If a police officer conducts a traffic stop on one of these off-road vehicles the driver of the vehicle could be issued a citation and his motorcycle could even be impounded because it is considered a public nuisance. Number of packages allowed on the bus: How many packages can I bring on the bus? Scheduled Route Service: each rider is allowed as many packages that they can carry in one trip onboard the bus. Large packages sharp objects and toxic items are not allowed on the bus. All packages must be in the control of the rider and cannot block a seat from another customer. All beverages must be sealed. New mall route: Will Havasu Area Transit have a bus route to the new mall in 2008? Subject to City Council approval HAT is planning to establish an 'Express' route to the shops at Lake Havasu Mall in the spring of 2008. The express route bus will be ADA accessible. Emergency repairs: What is considered an emergency repair? Any life and safety issue such as loss of air conditioning roof leaking plumbing electrical issues and septic and leach field issues is considered to be an emergency repair. Forgivable deferred loans: What is a deferred forgivable loan? This is a non-interest bearing loan that forgives itself over a period of time depending on the amount of repairs. There is a

lien on the property until it is satisfied. Automated Weather Observation System (AWOS): When will the AWOS be back in service? The present AWOS is 15 years old and there are no replacement parts. We are looking at the purchase of equipment to give Unicom operators non-certified wind direction and temperature. We are working with the FAA to fund a replacement AWOS. Once a new AWOS is in place the temporary equipment that we purchase will remain as backup. No Scheduled Commercial Air Service: Why did Lake Havasu City Municipal Airport lose commercial air service and what is the city doing about it? Mesa Airlines operating as U.S. Airways Express abandoned its two flights a day between Lake Havasu City and Sky Harbor International Airport on May 6 2007 with two weeks advance notice. No reason was given. The City Council has budgeted \$24 000.00 for consultant services to identify scheduled air carrier service. Land use application fees: Is my land use application fee refundable? No. The land use application fee is a processing fee used to cover staff costs involved in the advertising mailing distribution and review of an application. Whether an application is approved or denied the city cannot refund an application fee. Once an application is submitted and accepted by the city there are costs associated with that application that must be covered. Banners: Do I need a permit to place a banner at my business? Yes. A permit application is available from the Development Services Department and the annual fee is \$65.81. The size of a banner(s) is based on a maximum square footage not a certain number. Banners can only be placed on building walls. Freestanding banners banners on fences etc. are prohibited. Displaying merchandise: I own a retail business and was told I could not display my merchandise in front of my store but a similar business across town was allowed. Why can't I display my merchandise? The Development Code regulates outdoor display of merchandise by zoning district. The ability to display merchandise outside is dependent upon the zoning district a property is within not the type of business. The Development Code prohibits outdoor display within the C-1 (limited commercial) zoning district and allows outdoor display within the C-2 (general commercial) zoning district. History of permits issued for a property: How can I get a history of permits issued on my property?






Figure 1. <<<<<< LIKE A HOT KNIFE THROUGH BUTTER



You may submit an Information Request Form which is accessible though our website. The request will be processed within three to five business days. Pool enclosure compromised: My neighbor pushed dirt against my wall and has compromised my pool enclosure. Am I liable if someone or something comes into my pool? The property owner of the pool is responsible for maintaining the enclosure in compliance at all times. Structure design criteria: What is the structural design criteria for Lake Havasu? Wind: 90mph (exposure is determined by engineer); Seismic Design Category: C; Rainfall: 2 inches/hr. Fire hydrant color: Why are fire hydrants painted yellow? Lake Havasu City has traditionally painted fire hydrants yellow for better visibility especially at night. Utilities: What if there are existing utilities (water gas cable TV telephone etc.) that conflict with the sewer installation? When possible alternate alignments will be chosen. When this is not possible the utility company will have the conflicting utility moved. Miles of roads maintained by the city: How many miles of roads do the city departments maintain? The city currently maintains approximately 430 miles of roads. Traffic signal timing: How do I request an improvement to traffic signal timing? Please contact the Street Division at 855-3377 with a location and a description of your concern. City staff will then assess the situation and make a determination if changes are needed. Towels: Does your facility have towels for the public to use? No. We sell towels for \$4.00 each but do not have towels for rent. Pool temperature: How warm is the pool? Our main pool is an average of 86 degrees our therapeutic pool is an average of 97 degrees and our hot tub is an average of 101 degrees. Slide: Is the slide open? Yes. The slide is open during our open swim time and you must be 3 1/2 feet tall to ride. Waves: When do the waves activate? The waves begin during our open swim time and continue to run every 20 minutes for 10 minute intervals. Alcohol in parks: Can I have alcohol in a city park? What do I need to do? You would fill out a park permit within the reservation time. Alcohol must be contained under the ramada. No glass is allowed. No alcohol over the holidays. Snake removal: I have a snake at my house that doesn't belong there. What should I do? Call the non-emergency Police/Fire Dispatch at (928) 855-4111 and they will try to reach one of several

citizens who assist in snake removal. Of course if it is an emergency situation immediately dial 9-1-1. Bee information: I have bees in my water meter box. What should I do? As long as it is not an emergency situation where someone is getting attacked by the bees contact the Water Department at (928) 855-2618 and they will send someone out to remove the bees. Bee information: I have a swarm of bees at my house. Will the Fire Department come out and get rid of them? Keep in mind swarming bees will frequently move on and may not actually be setting up housekeeping at your location. If it is not a dangerous situation you may want to just wait and watch for a short time to see if they move on. The Fire Department will only come and destroy the bees on private property if it is an emergency situation where someone is getting attacked by the bees. In that case immediately dial 9-1-1 for Police/Fire Dispatch. In a non-emergency situation you will need to contact a pest control company for bee removal. Remember the easement at your house is not city property it is your property. Day and time of Fourth of July fireworks display: What day will the Fourth of July fireworks display be held on? The Fourth of July fireworks display is always held on July 4th regardless of the day of the week that it falls on. The approximate time is around 9:00 p.m. Beeping smoke detectors: My smoke detector is beeping even though I changed the battery. What should I do? There are several reasons that smoke detectors may beep with batteries being only one of the reasons. A smoke detector may also beep if it is dirty and/or in need of replacement. Weed burning: Can I burn the weeds in my yard? After you have obtained a no-fee burn permit you may burn small in-ground weeds only. Open Container of liquor inside a vehicle: I am going to visit Lake Havasu City soon. Is it legal for passengers inside of a vehicle to drink alcohol while driving around town? 
